How do I convert a photo to text?

With ABBYY FotoReader, you can easily transform information from paper documents into electronic files using your digital camera. It will take only few simple steps:

1. Photograph the text.



2. Connect your camera to your PC.



3. Launch ABBYY FotoReader.

4. Select the right document language in the Select New Task dialog box. Choose the Autoselect option if the photographed document contains text in two or more languages.



5. In the Get Image from Camera window, choose the desired operation. You can convert photos to Microsoft Word, Excel, PDF, and other text formats.



6. In the Open dialog box, select the photo you wish to convert. The converted document will appear in the application of your choice or will be saved as a file on your PC.
